Tuition Schedule for the 2024-2025 School Year

There is a \$75 non-refundable deposit required at the time of registration.

Tuition payments are due on the first of the month from September through May. If you would like to use a credit card/debit card payments will be set up automatically. You can also pay tuition by cash, check or bank online.

Below are the 2025-2026 monthly tuition rates:

2 days per week is \$194 per month	4 days per week is \$244 per month
3 days per week is \$234 per month	5 days per week is \$260 per month

The Hands-on Experience Includes:

Faith Experience: The children pray at the start of the day and at snack time. Bible stories are presented daily and Jesus is the focus of both Christmas and Easter.

Cognitive Development: Learning math concepts such as number recognition, counting, and values. In addition to knowing the upper and lower case letters, the children participate in activities such as sorting, classifying, sequencing, and beginning phonics. In the four/five-year-old class the children are introduced to basic sight words and the majority of the children are beginning to read when they complete the pre-kindergarten program.

Social Development: Learning appropriate interactions with others, taking turns, sharing, and treating each other with kindness and respect.

Language Development: Being able to communicate with appropriate words, being able to comprehend and follow directions. Children engage in music, finger plays, and prayer to enhance their language development.

Fine Motor: to gain strength and learn control to be able to write, children participate in art and sensory play.

Gross Motor: Opportunities to run, ride bikes, climb, bouncing-throwing-catching a ball, and free play are available every day. The children participate in an indoor gym for approximately 20 minutes daily.

PROGRAM SCHEDULE

Preschool begins the Monday before Labor Day and ends the last week of May, before Memorial Day weekend.

Our program is held from 9:15 a.m. until 11:45 a.m. for children ages two through Pre-Kindergarten.

Families may enroll for a minimum of two days or a maximum of five days. Families have the opportunity to select what days their child will attend the program.

The program follows the District 200 (Wheaton Schools) calendar for holidays, vacations and inclement weather.

Most asked Questions:

Does my child need to be toilet trained to attend the 2-year-old program? **No, the children in the 2 year old class do not need to be toilet trained to participate.**

Is Snack Provided? **Yes, the preschool program is a "peanut free" environment.**

Are children's birthdays celebrated at school? **Yes, we celebrate each child's special day. The celebration is done at snack time. Parents are welcome to bring a special treat that is on our list of peanut/egg free treats.**

What does my child need to bring to school? **Each child needs to bring a backpack with their name clearly labeled. The backpack should have a complete change of clothes, just in case. The 2-year-olds should bring their own diapers/wipes and a sippy cup please bring it. All items should have your child's name on it.**
