



THE HISTORY OF SAINT DANIEL CHURCH IN WHEATON



Saint Daniel the Prophet Parish was established on April 5, 1989, with Father Thomas White as the founding pastor. Father White planned and built all our parish facilities. The church building was dedicated on October 3, 1993, and the parish center building was completed on January 5, 2001. Father White retired in 2005.

Father Thomas Sularz became the second pastor of our church in 2005. Father Sularz renovated our church sanctuary, retired the debt on the parish center building, and celebrated the silver anniversary of our parish community.



When Father Sularz retired in 2014, Father James Dvorscak became the third pastor. On July 5, 2014, Father White died, and on July 15, 2018, Father Sularz died. Both priests left behind a legacy that will always be cherished!

In 2022, Father John Ouper became the fourth pastor of our parish. We look forward to his priestly service for many years to come. With the end of the historic pandemic, a whole new day is dawning for our parish community.
